

## **Tulalip Tribes Hunting Regulation**

DATE: November 8, 2006

REGULATION NO: 2006-01

EFFECTIVE DATE AND TIME: November 9, 2006

MODIFICATION TO ANNUAL HUNTING REGULATION: Section 3.3 of the Tulalip Annual Hunting Regulation is modified to read “The Tulalip Indian Reservation shall be open for hunting by Tulalip Tribal members. Migratory bird hunting off-Reservation is open under applicable federal regulations and paragraph 12 of these regulations.”

Under section 18. Open Areas and Seasons for Big Game Species there is a new section 18.1.1 that reads as follows; 18.1.1 The Tulalip Reservation: The Tulalip Reservation is open for hunting by tribal members. On reservation areas closed to hunting include all areas south and west of Marine Drive, all areas east of 27<sup>th</sup> Ave NE, north of 116<sup>th</sup> St. NE, north of 118<sup>th</sup> St. NE, and east of 11 Ave. NE (except the Quilceda Creek estuary and Big Flats area will be open for hunting). Within the hunting area, hunting around residences and developed areas is prohibited and there is a 200 meter no hunting zone around such areas.

REQUIREMENTS OF ANNUAL REGULATION: All rules, regulations, restrictions, permit requirements, hunting tag requirements, and any other provisions of the Tulalip Tribes 2006-2007 annual hunting regulation, except any that may be in conflict with the specific provisions of this regulation or a subsequent annual hunting regulation, remain in effect and apply to all hunting activities undertaken under this regulation.
